The current global warming have impacts on ecosystem and increasing change to our climate, including snowfall in the places that have never seen snow, high temperature of 40 Celsius or below-grade temperature.

There are many natural disasters occurring more frequently and have a worldwide effect, such as earthquake, tsunami in Thailand and Indian, Typhoon in Philippines, and heavy snowfall in Japan and New York.

Due to these disasters, a large number of people have no place to stay and are forced to live in a shelter. Many of these shelters have poor facility management which has an impact on occupational health. As creative, architects, designers, we need to find a solution to solving the housing problems for these people. This year, the key message for Architect' 14 is architect's role in society. The Association of Siamese Architects (ASA) has been established since 1934, as a professional association, what has we done to society so far?

It is a good time for us to seek solutions that can demonstrate how architecture can help people in times of urgent need caused by natural disasters. Creative, architects and designers are invited to design a disaster shelter for use by a large number of people displaced by various natural disasters. The maximum volume of the shelter shell not exceed to 80m³. There is no requirement for a specific site.

Selection Procedure

1. Stage One Judging - Seven design projects will be shortlisted by the Awards' Jury
2. Stage Two Judging - The shortlisted projects are required to make a presentation of their design project in person.

*** If the shortlisted entrants can't make a presentation of their design to the Awards' Jury, they shall be excluded from any consideration***





Prizes:

First Prize: THB 100,000 and Trophy

Second Prize: THB 40,000 and Trophy

5 Honorable Mentions: THB 20,000 and Trophy

Conditions of Entry:

1. The competition is opened to everyone, including foreigners.
2. No more than one application can be submitted. In the event that an applicant submits more than one application, all applications in which that person has participated will be excluded.
3. All entry submissions should have legal rights and copyrights to all the material submitted. If the project contains any material or elements that are not owned by the entrant, the submissions shall be excluded from any consideration.
4. The copyright of the project belongs to the submitter.
5. All material submitted may be displayed or published at the discretion of the Association of Siamese Architects under Royal Patronage.

Submission Requirement:

1. There is no restriction on the medium, colors or techniques use for the presentation.
2. The text should be a short description of the project and what its aims are. It should not be more than 500 words in length.
3. All written material shall be in Thai or English language only.
4. Each sheet shall be used in an upright position and limited to maximum 1 (one) sheet of A1 (594x840 mm) size on a stiff, light mounted, not more than 2 cm. thick.
5. Each sheet shall be numbered in consecutive Arabic numerals and provided with a project ID. Each ID should contain 3 uppercase characters and 4 digits in English (ex. ASA1234). The character and number should be 1" high and placed at the bottom right on the obverse side of each sheet.
6. All participants should submit a separate of A4 size paper containing the participant's real name, age, address and contact number along with a certified copied of identification in a sealed envelope with the project code on the bottom left of the envelope. The envelope should be pasted on the obverse side of each sheet
