Chamber of Architects of Turkey Antalya Branch has organized the event "Young Architects' Meeting" by unveiling a first of this kind in Turkey, with the purpose of gathering young architects, benefiting from their opinions in all subjects regarding architecture and above all, with the purpose of contributing to the trainings of young architects after their university education.

The first event was realized with the main theme "Turkish Architecture in EU Membership Process" in 2006. The main theme of the event we organized at an international level in 2009 was "Designing in the Future". In this context, The International the competition with the title "22nd Century House and/or Housing Zones" concept project was realized. The event has been organized under the auspices of UIA since 2010.

In 2015, Chamber of Architects of Turkey is launched International Young Architects' Ideas Awards within the theme of "Architecture Without Borders: Education Spaces For Kids". This single stage ideas awards programme is open to young architects worldwide in accordance with UIA-UNESCO regulations.

In this conceptual architectural competition, which invites its participants into a more profound understanding of the architectural dimensions of "border", "educational spaces for children" is selected as a functional ground on which new spatial thoughts can be tested. Contemporary World, which changes rapidly, requires new interpretations of educational spaces. In this framework the participants are expected to relieve the concept of "border" from conventional understandings developed by the adults while interpreting the contemporary problems of space from a pedagogic viewpoint.
